

M-37 Resurfacing and Reconstruction Newaygo County

City of Grant reconstruction: June - August 2018 Grant to Newaygo resurfacing: May - June 2018

What Is Being Done?

The Michigan Department of Transportation (MDOT) will invest \$2.6 million to resurface M-37 from the south city limit of Grant north to the southern junction of M-82 in the city of Newaygo. This project also includes reconstructing M-37 with new storm water drainage from Lee Street to State Street in the city of Grant.

How Will Traffic Be Affected?

During reconstruction and storm drainage work (green), northbound M-37 will be detoured (orange) east on 128th Street, north on Willow Avenue and then west on 120th Street/ State Street. Truck traffic (blue) will take 128th Street to Willow Avenue to 112th Street. The detour will be in place continuously from approximately June until August. One lane of southbound M-37 traffic will remain open throughout the project.

During resurfacing work (red), both directions of traffic will be maintained on one lane via flag control on weekdays in May and June.
