

ORDINANCE No. 14

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE OPERATION OF SNOWMOBILES

THE CITY OF GRANT ORDAINS:

1. This ordinance shall be known as the snowmobile ordinance.
2. This ordinance is passed under the City police power and is accordingly given immediate effect.
3. Operation of snowmobiles shall be lawful in said City as far off the travelled portion as possible on any street, in a reasonable manner, at speeds not to exceed 10 miles per hour for the purpose of travel to and from the area of use and operation on private property, owned or occupied by the user, or on private property of others, with written permission, unless otherwise prohibited herein.
4. It shall be unlawful to operate a snowmobile on the public sidewalk areas of the City.
5. It shall be unlawful to operate a snowmobile within the said City, between the hours of 10 P.M. and 8 A.M. The hours set herein are variable by the resolution of the Council as from time to time passed, posted, attached to this ordinance and available to the public at the office of the City Clerk.
6. It shall be unlawful to operate a snowmobile within said City, in conflict with legal travel by pedestrians and motor vehicles.
7. It shall be unlawful to operate a snowmobile within one block of any church during any church services.
8. Violation of this ordinance shall constitute a misdemeanor, punishable by a fine of not more than one hundred (\$100.00) dollars, and-or imprisonment in the County Jail for a period of not more than ninety (90) days. This ordinance shall be enforceable by the institution of a complaint by the City officer having knowledge of the facts by investigation.
9. Any part of this ordinance determined to be invalid by a Court of Law shall be severable from the remainder of the ordinance without legally affecting said remainder.
