

ORDINANCE No. 15-5

AMENDMENTS TO ORDINANCE REGULATING DISORDERLY CONDUCT

The City of Grant hereby ordains that the Ordinance Regulating Disorderly Conduct, Ordinance No. 15-4, is hereby amended to add the following acts which shall be deemed to constitute loitering within the meaning of the appropriate section of said ordinance:

- a) Congregate in such a fashion so as to obstruct the free and uninterrupted passage of the public.
- b) Obstruct vehicular traffic.
- c) Sit on the sidewalk.
- d) Sit on the exterior surface of a parked automobile, including any place on the fenders, hood and roof of such automobile.
- e) Lie on the sidewalk.
- f) Sit on the steps leading to any building open to the public or to which the public is invited,
- g) Stand between parked vehicles.
- h) Sit, lie or stand on, or occupy public structures or property in opposition to the primary function or use of said structure or property.

Ordinance No. 15-4 and this amendment thereto is deemed necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the City of Grant.
