

No persons' exceeding six in number at any one time shall loiter, idle or congregate in or on any public street, highway, alley, park or business parking lots, generally open to the public, between the hours of 7:00 p.m. and 7:00 a.m., immediately following.

Violation of the provisions of this Ordinance shall be a misdemeanor punishable by a fine of not more than One Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars and costs, or by imprisonment not to exceed Ninety days, or by both such fine and imprisonment.

This Ordinance is deemed an emergency for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the City of Grant and shall take immediate effect.


The active Mayor declared the resolution adopted.
