

Ordinance Number 44

"Unless 'Permitted' by the City of Grant, no person or persons shall operate any loud speaking radio or other sound amplifying devise upon any of the streets, avenues, alleys, parks, lakes or other public places in the city or upon any private premises in the city where sound of sufficient volume is capable of being heard from a distance of fifty (50) feet from any vehicle or (50) feet from any residence property line between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 9:00 p.m., or twenty-five (25) feet between the hours of 9:00 p.m. and 7:00 a.m."

A violation of this ordinance shall be considered a 'Civil Infraction' and a fine not to exceed \$125.00 shall be imposed for the first offense. Subsequent offenses shall be fined up to, but not exceeding \$250.00."

This 'Ordinance' shall take precedence over any other existing City Ordinance pertaining to audio devises as described herein."
