

Section 1: A person desiring to qualify him/herself or any other person as a candidate for any elective office under the charter of the City of Grant shall file with the clerk a properly filled out official nominating petition on forms furnished by the office of the clerk, or on the candidate's own printed forms complying substantially with the forms supplied by the clerk.

Section 2: Said petitions shall conform in all respects with Section 11.7 and all other sections of the City charter of the City of Grant.

Section 3: For elective offices decided by the ~~XXXX~~ November election, such petitions shall be filed with the clerk not later than 4:00 o'clock p.m. on the first Tuesday after the first Monday in August.

Section 4: For elective offices decided by special elections, such petitions shall be filed with the clerk not later than 4:00 o'clock p.m. on the seventh Monday preceeding the special election date.

Section 5: The clerk shall publish notice of the offices to be filled and of the last date and time for receiving nominating petitions not less than ten days prior thereto.

Section 6: The effective date of this ordinance shall be June 10, 1981

(This is considered an emergency ordinance, taking effect upon publication)
